## Good to know

We would like to inform you about some practical things during your stay:

- On the day of **departure**, the farmhouse parlour must be vacated by 11:00 am at the latest. If you would like to stay a little longer, this is often possible by prior arrangement.
- The peace and quiet of the Twente countryside is a valuable asset. We ask you to be considerate of this and to respect the peace and **quiet** after 22:00.
- There are several **terraces** on the farm, which you can of course use.
- At the back of the barn there is a covered **bicycle shelter** with a charging station for e-bikes. This is accessible through the last black door on the left-hand side (viewed from the front).
- A **container** for residual waste, glass and paper is located next to the car park, behind the hedge.
- You can use the **WIFI** on the farm and in the surrounding area free of charge.
- Hairdryer, umbrella, baby monitor and plug adapter can be **borrowed** on request.

## For your safety

- All rooms on the farm are equipped with fire alarms. If you hear the fire alarm, leave the room quietly and go to the central courtyard in front of the farmhouse entrance (the 'Onderschoer') for further instructions.
- There are several emergency exits in the farmhouse. Look carefully to see where you can get out quickly.
- There are several fire extinguishers in the farmhouse.



The stay on our farm and any assistance is always at your own risk. The agricultural area is absolutely not a playground. Please do not allow children to climb into the stables or on machines and feed supplies. There are also several water areas on our premises. Children should therefore always be under the supervision of their parents or carers.

When you are a guest at Erfgoed Bossem, you can not only see, smell and feel country life, but above all taste it! Everything you find below is prepared - as far as possible - with ingredients from our own farm and neighbouring farms.

### BREAKFAST OPTIONS

- **Breakfast buffet at the farm:** Standard breakfast times between 8:00 and 10:00 am
- **Breakfast Basket:** The basket will be brought to your accommodation at around 8.30 am. We ask you to return the basket by 12:00 noon at the latest.

### LUNCH OFFER

Well-stocked packed lunch for on the go or something tasty from our lunch menu.



### BEVERAGES

*There is a self-service bar in the main building.  
Please enter your name on a drinks menu and tick the appropriate drink. We will prepare a delicious coffee or tea fresh for you.*

### DINNER

We do not offer an à la carte menu - and that is a conscious decision. This allows us to use all parts of the beef for delicious dishes. It is important to us to treat everything that nature gives us as respectfully as possible.

To do justice to the no-waste principle, we ask you to let us know by 5.00 pm on the day in question at the latest (preferably earlier) whether you would like to eat with us.

Are certain allergens a problem? Do you prefer a vegetarian diet? Our kitchen team will be happy to receive your feedback so that we can adapt the dishes accordingly.





## For dog owners

Is your dog with you? How nice! Please observe the following instructions:

- Do not let your dog on the chairs, sofas or beds.
- If you are staying in guest rooms where food is served, please contact us.
- Keep your dog on a lead to avoid disturbing other guests and to protect our small animals.
- Do not allow the dog to relieve itself in or around the courtyard. If it happens accidentally, please remove the faeces.
- Do not take your dog to the meadows because of Neospora. Cows can become infected with this parasite. If they eat feed that has come into contact with dog faeces, this can lead to major fertility problems in cattle.



### WALKABOUT

Of course, your dog is on holiday too, so treat him to a nice walk where he can perhaps be let off the lead:

- From the old farmhouse, walk round the building on the **right**. Leave the lane and then turn **right** (Frensdorferweg, **ATTENTION:** this is a fast road).
- Before the bridge, turn **right** onto the cycle path that runs alongside the diversion canal.
- Follow the cycle path to the end (turn round halfway).
- At the end, turn **right** (Ottershagenweg). Take your dog on a lead in good time, as this road is not without danger.
- Take the first **right** (Horstweg).
- Walk to the end of this road. Turn **right** twice there. This will take you back to the site.

**Does your dog like swimming?** Then go straight ahead at the bridge in the direction of the Cosmos Observatory. After the observatory, there is another bridge over the Dinkel. Immediately afterwards, you can turn left into a nature reserve with a pond. There is a footpath around the pond; please do not let your dog run free in the bushes around the pond.
